Program Hours:

Drop off is between the hours of 7:30 a.m-8:00 a.m Pick up is between 4:30 p.m-5:00 p.m

Child Information Form/Waiver:

Waiver can be found included in the program information email. This Waiver Must be completed prior to the beginning of a camp week.

What To Wear:

Campers should come in gym clothing and/or bring gym wear to change into along with occasionally bringing clothes that can be worn during water days.

Sign In/Out Policy:

There is a section on the Child Information Form/Waiver where you can list individuals authorized to pick up or drop off your child but parent/guardian must call before pick up to inform staff of the change. If someone not listed arrives to pick up your child, they will not be allowed to take the child unless we have received a call from the parent/guardian informing us of the change and the individual may need to show a form of ID.

Late Pick Up Policy:

All children must be picked up by 5 p.m each day they attend camp. The first late pick-up offense will result in a warning letter. The second offense will result in a late pick-up charge. The third offense could result in the removal of your child/children from the program.

Lunch and Snacks:

In an effort to promote a healthier lifestyle for today's youth, please make sure your child has enough healthy snacks, drinks, and a lunch to last the day. Please make sure to provide lots of water for your child to keep them well hydrated throughout the day.

Games

During this time, children will be able to play in small and large group games with friends!

Discipline:

Our expectation is that the children enjoy the program and respect others during all activities. We take a positive approach to discipline, striving to be fair, reasonable and consistent. When discipline problems arise, if we need to use a discipline form, the staff person and the child will discuss the situation and discover ways to redirect and problem-solve the behavior. In most cases a discipline form will be presented at pick up time for a parent/guardian to read over and sign. The signed form must be returned to camp before the child can return to the program. If there are continual discipline problems, staff may request a meeting to discuss alternative solutions which can include dismissal from the program. If the offense is serious, the child may be dismissed from the program without a refund.

Backpacks, Coats, & Personal Items:

Staff have the children line their items up in an orderly fashion along the wall. Please be sure your children's names are on their items. Day Camp is not responsible for any damage or loss that might be caused to personal items.

Refund Policy:

Refunds, credits or transfers must be requested 5 working days (Mon-Fri) prior to the start date of the camp week that they are registered for.

Safety is our top priority at Monette Martial Arts. We maintain a clean and sanitized training facility. We closely adhere to all health and safety guidelines to ensure the well-being of all campers and staff members.

Please take some time to review our camp program, which contains important information about our daily schedule. We encourage open communication and collaboration between our staff and parents, and we are always available to address any questions or concerns you may have.
